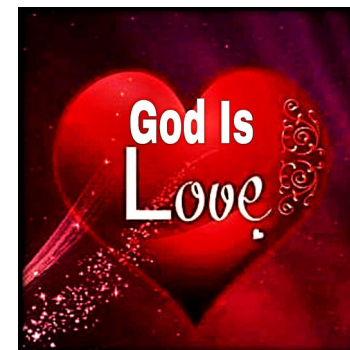
CONVERSION OF ST. PAUL

Thomas Aquinas (1225-1274) was one of the most important philosophers and theologians of the Catholic religion. He was born in 1225 in Roccaseca, a castle in the Frosinone province. His family was of noble origin. His parents were the Counts of Aquino, Landulf of Aquino and Donna Teodora Galluccio. Thanks to the political and social connections of his parents, he entered the monastery of Monte Cassino to study at the age of 5. There he learned topics such as grammar, music, morals, and the basic precepts of the Catholic religion. Later he moved from Aquino to study at the University of Naples. There he had his first contact with the ideas of Aristotle.

In 1244, Thomas Aquinas decided to join the Dominican order. This angered his family as the familial tradition was to be ordained with the Benedictine monks. To avoid this, his family ordered his brothers to capture him, and he was kept captive. He spent those days teaching his sisters. As soon as he could, he escaped and traveled to Paris to continue his studies. In 1245 he entered the University of Paris, which was famous for being one of the best in theology. There he met excellent teachers like Albertus Magnus with whom he learned more about the works of Aristotle. With him, he traveled for a period to Cologne and was ordained a priest in 1250. He returned to Paris in 1252 to continue his studies. In 1256 he achieved his doctorate in theology. Soon he obtained the position of professor of philosophy at the University of Paris.
