St. Paul of the Cross



The Passionists, formally known as the Congregation of the Passion of Jesus Christ are a Catholic clerical religious congregation of Pontifical Right for men founded by Saint Paul of the Cross with a special emphasis on and devotion to the Passion of Jesus Christ. Professed members add the initials C.P. after their names to indicate membership in the Congregation. A known symbol of the congregation is the labeled emblem of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, surmounted by a cross and is often sewn into the clothing attire of its congregants. The present superior general is Rev. Father Joachim Rego, C.P.

St. John Paul II, Pope



Pope John Paul II was the head of the Catholic Church and sovereign of the Vatican City State from 1978 until his death in 2005. He was elected pope by the second papal conclave of 1978, which was called after John Paul I, who had been elected in August to succeed Pope Paul VI, died after 33 days. Cardinal Wojtyła was elected on the third day of the conclave and adopted the name of his predecessor in tribute to him. John Paul II is recognized as helping to end Communist rule in his native Poland and the rest of Europe.

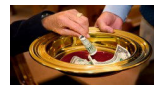
