Sunday, November 12, 2023 we celebrated Fr. Frankline's birthday at St. Charles along with his family from Texas.



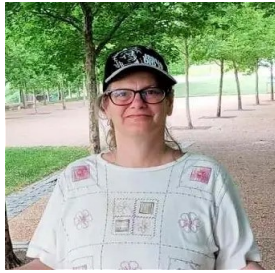
