

LENT

Pray + Fast + Give

Wednesday (22 February) is Ash Wednesday, and it begins our march to the celebration of the evidence of our salvation—Jesus' resurrection from the dead, i.e., Easter, Sunday. Although it can be described as a "march", Lent need not be a "forced march" that we come to dread. It is more than just a time in which we "give something up for Lent"—coffee, chocolates, desserts, etc. Rather, it is a time to reflect on our lives, "to do right, to love goodness, and to walk humbly with [our] God" (Micah 6:8).

Lent is the forty day period before Easter, excluding Sundays, which begins on Ash Wednesday (February 22, 2023) and ends on Holy Saturday (April 8, 2023). All Fridays in Lent are days of abstinence. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of Fast and Abstinence.

Fast: Limit of one full meal on these days for all between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive.


Abstinence: All who have reached their 14th year are bound to abstain totally from meat.

Easter Duty Obligation:

The Sacrament of Reconciliation and Holy Communion must be received during Lent.
