Divine Mercy Sunday is celebrated on the second Sunday of Easter, which marks the end of the Easter Octave. In 2024, this significant observance falls on April 7th. It's a time for reflection on the Christian faith, emphasizing the gifts of mercy and love that flowed from Christ's death, burial, and resurrection. As Pope John Paul II eloquently stated, "It is a time where we are blessed with divine mercy as it reaches us through the heart of Christ crucified".

The history of Divine Mercy Sunday traces back to St. Faustina Kowalska, a Polish nun who experienced visions from Christ himself. Born in 1905, she communed with Jesus, who expressed his desire to be "a refuge and a shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners." St. Faustina, also known as the 'Secretary of Divine Mercy,' passed away in 1938, leaving behind a legacy of reconciliation, faith, and God's mercy.

On this special day, people from all walks of life can humbly approach God, seeking His mercy, love, and forgiveness. It's a reminder of how Jesus offered His forgiveness and mercy to us, urging us to extend the same kindness throughout our lives. So, let us embrace Divine Mercy Sunday as a time to reflect, seek forgiveness, and celebrate the ultimate gift that Christ bestowed upon humanity after His crucifixion.



The Annunciation of the Lord Monday, April 8, 2024

The Solemnity of the Annunciation is celebrated nine months before the Nativity of the Lord, a feast which came about earlier historically. The Annunciation recalls the day when the Archangel Gabriel appeared to Mary and revealed God's will that she become the Mother of the Son of God, and she accepted. At that moment, the "Word became Flesh and dwelt among us" (John 1:14).

In 2024, because it would otherwise fall during Holy Week, the Annunciation will be observed on Monday, April 8.

We will start 15 minutes before Adoration and will provide music during the Holy Hour.


We will be there during Mass and after Mass as we will continue with Praise and Worship music, healing prayers and teaching.
