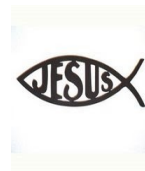

Please contact the office to make an appointment with Deacon and Clergy. Marriage prep must take place at least 6 months prior to the wedding.

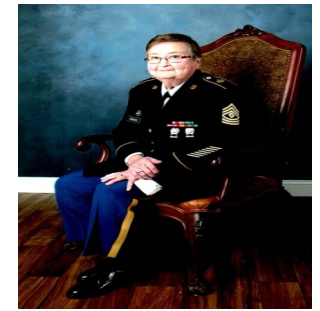
