John Vianney (born John-Mary Baptiste Vianney. Jean-Marie Baptiste Vianney in French; 8 May 1786 – 4 August 1859), venerated as **Saint John Vianney**, was a French Catholic Priest who is venerated in the Catholic Church as a saint and as the patron saint of parish priests. He is often referred to as the "*Curé d'Ars*" (i.e. the parish priest of Ars), internationally known for his priestly and pastoral work in his parish in Ars, France, because of the radical spiritual transformation of the community and its surroundings. Catholics attribute this to his saintly life, mortification, persevering ministry in the sacrament of confession, and ardent devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary. His feast day is August 4.



The Transfiguration of Jesus is an event described in the New Testament, where Jesus is transfigured and becomes radiant in glory upon a mountain. The Synoptic Gospels recount the occasion, and the Second Epistle of Peter also refers to it.
