Grand Knight: Bruce W. Large

Large grew up in Stow, Ohio. He and his family moved to Alabama in 1991. Large came into full communion with the Catholic Church 15 years ago. Large said he joined the Knights “To be part of a fraternal organization that supports our church and its' community.”

Deputy Grand Knight: Paul D. Guyer

Guyer grew up in Vermont and claims St. Elizabeth's in Lyndonville, Vt., as his home parish. The Guyer family moved to Alabama in 1992. About joining the Knights, Guyer said, “I like serving the community. What better way to serve than being a Knight?

Chaplain: Deacon A.B. King

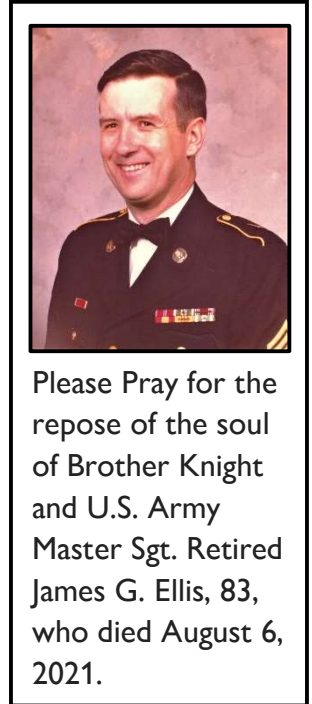

Treasurer: Ronald B. Neal

Neal grew up in Louisville, Ky, a member of St. Francis of Assisi Parish. He moved to Alabama after graduating from graduate school in 1974. The ‘cradle’ Catholic said being a Knight “Is a good way for me to serve the church and the community.”

Financial Secretary: Stephen R. Sullivan

Another ‘cradle’ Catholic, Sullivan is from Manchester, Conn., and St. James Catholic Church. He moved his family to Alabama in 1983 when the Army stationed him at Fort McClellan.
