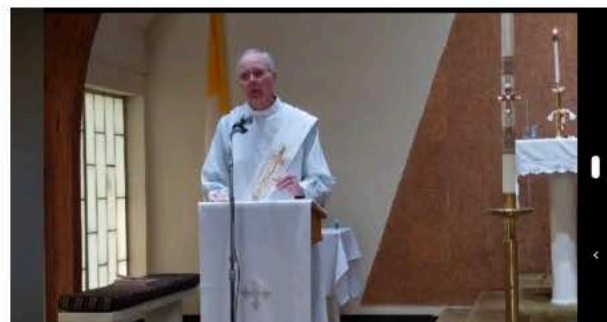
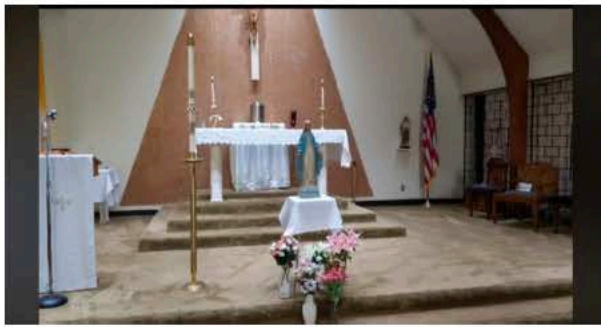

The State of Alabama now allows for church services to be held WITH PROVISIONS. Therefore, we are working to get a plan in place to restart public Mass. While we are very excited to be in the position to have parishioners attend Mass, please keep in mind that **Bishop Baker has issued a DISPENSATION OF ALL FROM THE MASS OBLIGATION until June 30th**. Therefore, it is **not required** that you attend Mass. If you are concerned about attending, pregnant, above the age of 65, or have any medical conditions that put you at a higher risk for complications, it is advised that you stay home. If you feel you are sick, we ask that you do not attend any church function.

During this time we **WILL CONTINUE FACEBOOK LIVE, YOUTUBE AND DRIVE-THRU COMMUNION AND CONFESSION**. Drive-thru Confession and Communion will follow each Mass for approximately 20 minutes following each weekend Mass. More details will be listed

In order to hold public Mass services, we must be able to follow the guidelines set in place. To do this with the required social distancing, we must know what households plan to attend Mass, which day you plan on attending, and how many from that household will be present. We need this information BY FRIDAY OF EACH WEEK. This way we can take the appropriate steps to ensure appropriate social distancing and sanitizing. If we do not have you on the list, we can not guarantee you will be allowed into the church. Seats will be assigned on a first-come, first-serve basis. Should we fill the designated seats, we will let you know and you will be first in line for the next available Mass. **Please contact Tricia at the church office at 256-435-3238 if you plan to attend Mass. If the office is closed or you get the answering machine, please leave a message with your family name and the number attending.**

After each Mass, we must undergo a sanitizing of church. We are looking for volunteers to perform the required sanitizing. This will not take long and will consist of wiping down designated surfaces. Also, if you have access to additional hand sanitizer or disinfectant wipes, please let us know. **We are trying to keep hand sanitizer available, but it is recommended that you BRING YOUR OWN.**

Please also know that the restrooms WILL NOT be sanitized between uses. Therefore, it is advised that you avoid using the church restroom if at all possible.
